Frequently Asked Questions!

Transportation

- Dulles Bus Stop: Buses meet at the <u>Dulles North Transit Center</u>: 23200 Pacific Boulevard, Sterling, VA 20166.
- Buses depart at 9:30 am on Sunday and arrive back at 2pm on Saturday
- If you are driving to camp, please plan to arrive between 11am and 2pm for dropoff, and before 12pm for pickup

Communication

- With the use of Bunk1 Credits, you can write emails to your camper as often as you like, and they will be printed daily at 11am. Campers can reply to you by writing mail to be sent in the post. Postcards (with stamps & address) are a great idea!
- You may also schedule an optional phone call with your camper, calls are only available at meal times and during the second week of the session.



Frequently Asked Questions! cont.

- How often is laundry done?
 - At least once a session, usually twice for our youngest campers
 - As needed in case of accidents
- Who makes the campers' beds?
 - They do! Each morning, campers have Cabin Cleanup where they work together to keep their cabin and personal areas tidy - the cleanest cabin at the end of the session celebrates with an ice cream party!
- How old are your counselors? Where do they come from?
 - Counselors range in age from 19-25, each having completed one year in college (or out of high school). We conduct criminal background checks and require 3 references for all staff members each year. This year, 40% of our staff grew up attending Camp Twin Creeks as campers.
